USGA Rules Govern All Play

EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

Out of Bounds:

Fence and road on holes 9, 10 & 11.

Hazards - Red Stakes:

Drop ball within two club lengths of where the ball last crossed the hazard line.

Temporary Water:

Drainage ditch on 18.

Flag Placements:

Red - Front; White - Middle; Blue - Back

Pace of Play & Course Procedures

- Avoid slow play. Pace of Play is strictly enforced. Pace of Play is 4 hours & 8 minutes. Keep pace with the group ahead of you.
- No more than 4 players per group are allowed. Do not hit into the group in front of your group.
- No outside food, beverages or personal coolers are allowed on the premises.
- Please replace divots, rake sand bunkers, & fix ball marks on greens.
- Keep carts on the path on all Par 3's.
- Proper golf attire is required. No denim is allowed & shirts with collars are required.
- Soft Spikes are required. No metal spikes.
- Must be 19 years of age to operate golf carts.
- Golfers are responsible for personal property damage.
- In case of dangerous weather, a horn will be blown. All golfers should return to the clubhouse immediately.
